How can a console make the most of your radio system?

- Two-way radio systems facilitate communications among hospital staff, ambulance personnel and other urgent-care facilities.
 - ER Communications with ambulance, medical evacuation helicopters, other agencies when assistance in transportation is required.
 - Consoles can have different city agencies and phone systems to patch to the hospital radio systems.
 - Some hospitals have transportation provided for employees from parking to hospital working location.
- **Paging systems** are used to notify doctors and nurses, emergency response teams and other hospital staff.
- Remote-monitoring-and-control systems notify
 personnel of building security issues, maintenance
 problems and critical equipment malfunctions. These
 alerts can be set up to go through the console or
 pre-programmed conditions can be transmitted to
 handheld portables and mobile radios.
- Alarm monitoring and control systems provide added protection of the facilities with around-the-clock surveillance, alarm reporting and automated control.
